

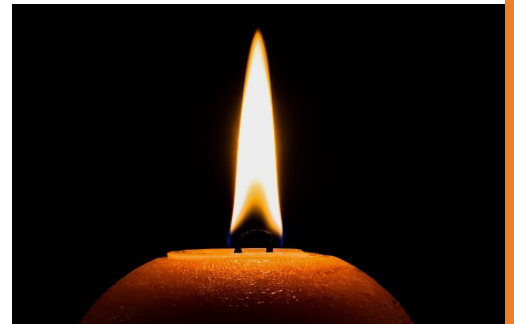


# Interfaith Story Circle
